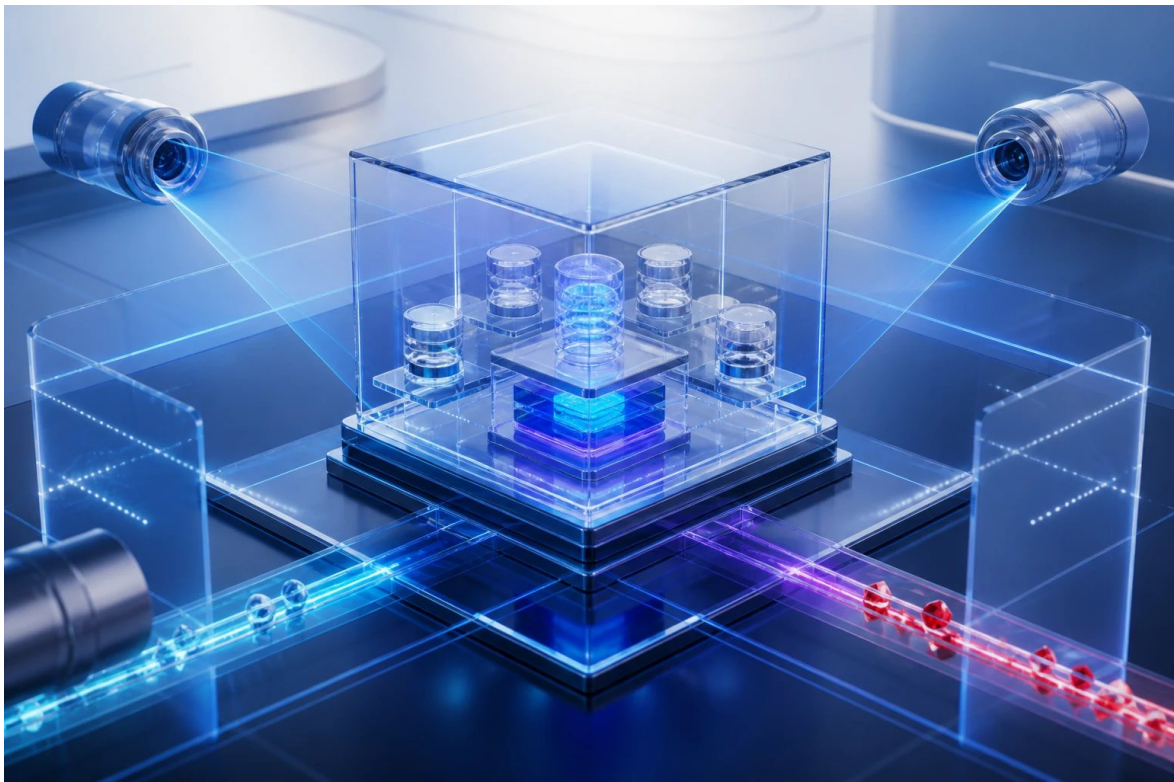

Product overview

Eagle Eye Assurance helps security teams organise approved assurance work around evidence and decisions. It creates a shared view of scope, observations, remediation and reporting while keeping deeper specialist testing and independent validation in the engagement where they belong.

Eagle Eye Assurance is designed for security leaders, assurance teams and service providers coordinating recurring customer security reviews. It connects assurance scope and engagement records, risk-focused dashboards and export and audit support so teams can move from input to accountable action without losing the decision trail.

The product supports the operating workflow; it does not remove professional judgement, statutory responsibility or customer ownership. Final controls, integrations and commercial scope are confirmed during discovery and recorded in the implementation plan.

Customer challenges it addresses

- 01** Information about assurance scope and engagement records, evidence and finding management and risk-focused dashboards often lives in separate tools, inboxes or spreadsheets, making the operating picture difficult to trust.
- 02** When teams need to capture evidence and validate findings, manual hand-offs can hide ownership, delay decisions and make exceptions harder to resolve.
- 03** Leaders need a clearer way to achieve executive visibility while preserving human approval, role boundaries and an understandable record of what happened.

Detailed capabilities

Six connected capabilities shape the core Eagle Eye Assurance operating experience.

01

Assurance scope and engagement records

Define the authorised assurance boundary, objectives and engagement context before evidence or findings are recorded.

02

Evidence and finding management

Organise supporting material around the relevant matter or review so users can understand provenance and purpose.

03

Risk-focused dashboards

Prioritise assurance information using business and risk context so technical observations support clear decisions.

04

Remediation ownership

Assign corrective work, follow status and preserve closure evidence without losing the original finding context.

05

Customer-ready reporting

Translate approved assurance results into clear customer and executive reporting with traceable source context.

06

Export and audit support

Keep service interactions connected to the customer record so commercial and delivery teams share the same context.

Connected operating model

The capabilities are designed to work together. Assurance scope and engagement records establishes context, risk-focused dashboards moves the work forward, and export and audit support supports review and accountability.

How teams use the product

The workflow is intentionally simple to understand, while retaining visible owners, review points and evidence.

01

Define authorised assurance scope

Authorised users combine assurance scope and engagement records and evidence and finding management to define authorised assurance scope. The workflow keeps the responsible owner, review point and resulting action visible.

02

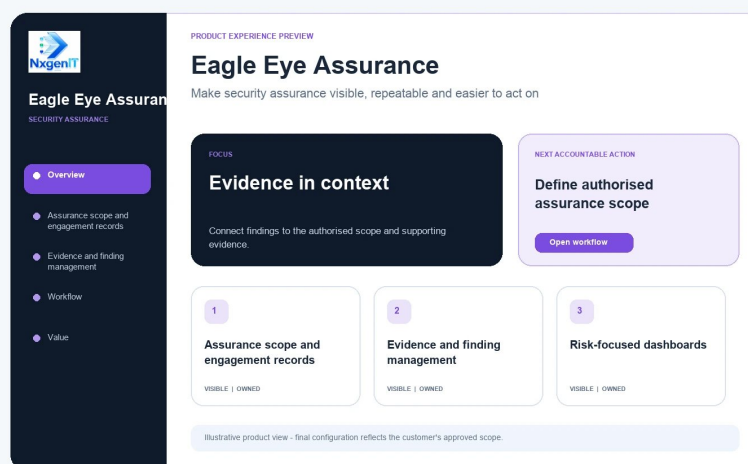
Capture evidence and validate findings

Authorised users combine risk-focused dashboards and remediation ownership to capture evidence and validate findings. The workflow keeps the responsible owner, review point and resulting action visible.

03

Track remediation and report outcomes

Authorised users combine customer-ready reporting and export and audit support to track remediation and report outcomes. The workflow keeps the responsible owner, review point and resulting action visible.

Rollout, governance and success

A controlled rollout keeps the product aligned to customer ownership, real operating roles and measurable outcomes.

PHASE 01

Discover and scope

Confirm the users, operating boundaries, source data and decisions that Eagle Eye Assurance must support.

PHASE 02

Configure roles and controls

Define authorised roles, approval points, protected information and escalation paths before customer data is introduced.

PHASE 03

Prepare data and connections

Map the required inputs for assurance scope and engagement records and evidence and finding management, including migration or integration needs.

PHASE 04

Pilot, validate and scale

Run a controlled pilot, review outcomes with responsible users, adjust the workflow and expand only after acceptance.

Roles, ownership and control

Eagle Eye Assurance is configured around named users, authorised roles and explicit approval points. Customer data remains customer-owned, protected information is limited to appropriate roles, and important actions retain an understandable history.

What success can look like

- Shorter cycle time across 'Define authorised assurance scope'.
- Fewer unresolved exceptions around risk-focused dashboards.
- Clearer ownership of approvals, follow-ups and closure evidence.
- Stronger adoption among the intended users and responsible reviewers.
